

2022 La Sirena Cabernet Sauvignon

Winemaker Notes/Fact Sheet

Cabernet Sauvignon is our flagship wine for La Sirena, and the best example of the elegance, balance, and beautiful opulence that I strive for in my red wines. Cabernet Sauvignon is what I am best known for, what I have built my 30+ year reputation on, as well as my favorite wine to make. Cabernet lovers will recognize the winemaking style which is similar in blend profile to the famous and much-loved Screaming Eagle wines I made previously. With the richness & depth of Napa Valley Cabernet fruit on display, La Sirena Cabernet Sauvignon has a 25+ year tradition of age-worthiness, velvety structure & powerful presence that has impressed wine lovers around the world.

Blend: 85% Cabernet Sauvignon, 13% Merlot, 2% Cab Franc

Tasting Notes: Tasted 10/1/25 by Heidi (and Bo!)

The 2022 La Sirena Cab is a dark, inky berry color. Bold aromas rise from the glass with gorgeous fruit notes of ripe blackberry, dark cherry and ripe currants, layered with accents of French oak, tea leaves, hints of vanilla and baking spice, and minerality from this hillside vineyard's volcanic soil. Across the palate it has beautiful structure, balance and velvety texture, layers of fruit with complexity, and a long, captivating finish. It's a beauty now, but will continue to develop and expand in the bottle – we expect this wine to age for 20 years or more.

Why "La Sirena"? The name means "the Mermaid" in Spanish and Italian. I chose it because I'm a lifelong ocean lover, longtime scuba diver, and wanted a winery name that was fun & magical (like wine) and also personal to me. The first vintage of La Sirena was 1994, with the first Cabernet Sauvignon made in 1996. Our current wine lineup: Cabernet Sauvignon, Chardonnay, Moscato Azul (dry Muscat Canelli), Rosato (rosé of Primitivo), and our two fun and tasty proprietary winemaker red blends, Studio Series and Pirate TreasuRed. Production is always small, focusing on fine wines of purity and excellence. Wishing you all the best!
